



Around The Pacific Ocean

The **Pacific Ocean** is the largest of the Earth's oceanic divisions. It extends from the Arctic in the north to the Southern Ocean (or, depending on definition, to Antarctica), in the south, bounded by Asia and Australia in the west, and the Americas in the east.

At 165.2 million square kilometers (63.8 million square miles) in area, this largest division of the World Ocean - covers about 46% of the Earth's water surface and about one-third of its total surface area, making it larger than all of the Earth's land area combined.
